

## MOSSBOSS ROOF WASH – RETAIL

- Description:** MossBoss Roof Wash is a safe, efficient material for the elimination of moss, lichen, algae and mould from most surfaces. It can be used on roofs, pathways, patios, timber decks and weather boards. It is effective, environmentally friendly and biodegradable.
- Application:** Do not mix with other chemicals. Do not apply if rain is expected within 12 hours.
- Add 1 part of MossBoss to 4 parts of clean water.**  
Stir well to ensure complete mixing.  
Apply with a low pressure garden sprayer. Best applied in dry overcast conditions. Thoroughly wet the surface and walk away. Leave for a few days and remove the dead growth with a stiff brush or high pressure hose or simply let the moss, lichen, algae and mould die and erode away with the weather.  
Moss Boss does not show immediate results but it works slowly and effectively without damaging the surface.
- Caution:** Roofs: If the roof is used to collect drinking water, disconnect tank inlet pipes until the roof has had at least 6 mm of rain. This may be a period of 2 – 4 weeks.
- Coverage:** Coverage will depend on the amount of growth to be cleaned. On porous surfaces 1 litre will cover approximately 5 square metres and up to 10 square metres on nonporous surfaces. One 5 litre container of MossBoss will cover 125 – 250 square metres.
- Storage & Disposal:** Store this product in its original container tightly closed away from direct sunlight. Do not store with foodstuffs, oxidising chemicals or acids. Dispose of empty container safely through an industrial waste collection.
- Health & Safety:** Avoid breathing mist and ensure adequate ventilation when using this product. Wear gloves, safety glasses and protective clothing. Wash hands after application and before meals. Wash splashes from skin immediately. For full details refer to the **Safety Data Sheet for this product.**
